Registered Nurse (Chemotherapy)

NOC is seeking an experienced **Registered Nurse (Chemotherapy)** to join our team. The position is full time, Monday – Friday from 08h00 – 17h00.

The Registered Nurse will be responsible for the provision of professional nursing care by administering chemotherapy to both in-and out-patients in the Namibian Oncology Centre, whilst adhering to company policies, standards and following prescribed company procedures.

Responsibilities:

- Ensures the safe handling, administration and disposal of chemotherapy drugs, biotherapy and related therapies, monitoring chemotherapy patients continually during and after treatment
- Ensures efficient and appropriate scheduling of patient chemotherapy appointments
- Proficient in the access and maintenance of A-ports and J-lines and other forms of intravenous access
- Proficient in the prevention and management of adverse treatment reactions
- Documents all procedures and activities pertaining to chemotherapy administration, accurately and efficiently, including daily patient statistics
- Provides psychosocial support for patient and family members during treatment, including patient orientation and education
- Manages consumable stock and supplies for the chemotherapy department
- Manages patient treatment authorisations and fees for service
- Correct interpretation and management of blood results
- Development of chemotherapy protocols and adherence to established protocols
- Management of the emergency trolley, replacing used stock timeously
- Able to work independently

Minimum requirements:

- Relevant Degree or Diploma in Nursing
- Current registration with the Health Professions Council of Namibia as a Registered Nurse
- Minimum 5 years post-basic clinical experience, recent clinical experience
- Chemotherapy administration experience or post-basic Oncology qualification will be advantageous
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills with the ability to effectively communicate with patients and colleagues
- Fluency in English, additional languages will be an advantage
- Demonstrable evidence of IT skills
- Namibian citizenship or residency status
