Job Title: Plumber

The plumber is responsible for the installation, inspection, repair, and maintenance of all plumbing systems. This includes water supply, drainage, sanitation and associated fixtures to ensure operations remain uninterrupted. The role requires responsiveness to both routine maintenance and urgent repairs.

The responsibilities of this position include but are not limited to, the following:

- Install, maintain, and repair plumbing systems, including pipes, fittings, toilets, sinks, and water heaters.
- Plan and install water systems for new residential builds.
- Read, interpret, and follow drawings and blueprints when laying out plumbing systems.
- Respond promptly to plumbing-related maintenance requests.
- Respond to and address callouts and emergencies.
- Perform regular inspections and preventive maintenance on plumbing infrastructure.
- Diagnose and troubleshoot leaks, blockages, and other plumbing faults.
- Ensure all plumbing systems comply with health, safety, and environmental standards.
- Coordinate with the Reserve Manager to plan and prioritize repair schedules.
- Ensure that water is pumped daily and that the pump is serviced when needed.
- Maintenance and cleaning of the pool and surrounding areas.
- Collaborate with external contractors and suppliers when necessary.
- Assist other maintenance personnel with general lodge upkeep when required.

Applicants need to fulfil the following requirements:

- Valid grade 12 certificate
- Recognized plumbing qualification or trade certification
- Minimum 3 years of practical plumbing experience, preferably in a hospitality or lodge environment.
- Proven ability to work independently and handle emergency repairs efficiently.
- Good understanding of health and safety standards related to plumbing work.
- Physically fit and able to work in various indoor and outdoor environments.
- Basic knowledge of other general maintenance disciplines.
- Strong problem-solving skills and attention to detail.
- Willingness to live on-site or be on call for emergencies as required
