Information Security Specialist (D2)

Job Competencies Include:

This role entails safeguarding MTC's IT infrastructure by implementing, monitoring, and maintaining robust security measures across systems, networks, and applications. The role ensures compliance with internal policies and external regulations, mitigates risks, and responds to security incidents.

- Monitor and analyse security alerts from SIEM, EDR, firewall logs, and intrusion detection systems
- Detect, analyse and respond to security incidents and breaches
- Configure the tuning of threat detection tools to reduce false positives and improve detection rates
- Configure and implement endpoint protection, malware defense, and secure configurations
- Maintain documentation of threat intelligence sources, detection use cases, and tool configurations
- Monitor privileged access usage and report anomalies or violations
- Manage user access, RBAC, PAM, MFA, and SSO implementations, and user lifecycle processes
- Support IAM policy implementation and provide user support for authentication issues
- Configure and maintain firewalls, VPNs, and secure network architectures
- Assist with security risk assessments across business units, applications, and third-party vendors
- Update the cybersecurity risk register under guidance and monitor open risk remediation items
- Track compliance with security policies, controls, and regulatory requirements (e.g., POPIA, ISO 27001)
- Log and triage security incidents and track through to resolution
- Participate in root cause analysis and document incident reports and lessons learned
- Support tabletop exercises and help maintain response playbooks
- Monitor systems for security breaches and respond to incidents promptly
- Conduct forensic investigations and document findings and maintain audit trails and logs for compliance and reporting
- Enforce and implement IT security policies, standards, and procedures
- Ensure alignment with frameworks such as ISO 27001, NIST, ITL, COBIT etc.
- Maintain up-to-date SOPs, configuration documents, playbooks, and policy compliance checklists
- Record asset security classifications and data protection levels in inventory systems
- Log metrics related to system uptime, false positives, detection success, and user activity
- Track SLA adherence for security-related services and support internal and external audits by providing accurate documentation
