Job Title: Canine (K9) Handler Department: Operations & Conservation

The Canine (K9) Handler is responsible for the care and operational deployment of working dogs in support of anti-poaching and security operations within a conservation landscape.

This role requires an effective and professional partnership between handler and dog, maintaining operational readiness while upholding the highest standards of animal welfare.

The responsibilities of this position include but are not limited to the following:

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Handle, deploy, and maintain trained K9s for tracking, detection, and patrol duties.
- Ensure the health, welfare and daily care of the K9s, including feeding, grooming, exercise, veterinary needs, etc.
- Maintain discipline and operational readiness of both handler and K9s at all times.
- Keep accurate records of deployments, training progress, health and welfare logs and inventory.
- Responsible for kennels, equipment readiness, K9 unit facilities and training areas.
- Work closely with the Anti-Poaching Units and law enforcement partners when required.
- Conduct regular training exercises to maintain and improve operational capability.
- Maintain the highest standards of ethical treatment, handling and positive training methods for the K9s.

Requirements:

- Strong passion for animal health, welfare and conservation.
- Eagerness to work with and for a K9.
- Proven experience as a K9 handler preferred (tracking and/or detection).
- Basic understanding of animal behaviour, training methods and health care.
- Recognized K9 handling or training certification would be advantageous.
- Physically fit and able to work in remote environments with potential encounters of dangerous wildlife.
- Valid driver's license.
- Basic weapon handling and bush survival skills an advantage.
- Basic administrative skills and record keeping skills.
- Willingness to work irregular hours, including nights and weekends.
- Integrity, discipline and ability to work in a team under pressure.
