The responsibilities of this position include but are not limited to, the following:

- Cleaning and tidying the rooms and other areas of responsibility throughout including: ventilating, dusting, floor cleaning and other various surfaces according to housekeeping procedures, standards and products.
- Ensuring that all linen is kept in a good state of repair, correctly marked and correctly stored.
- Ensuring that outgoing and incoming linen is controlled to ensure minimum linen loss.
- Ensuring that the linen is washed and ironed in accordance with required specification.
- Do regular spring cleaning of all rooms.
- Ensuring that all unoccupied rooms are checked daily, confirming room status, cleanliness and maintenance defects.
- Helping with full linen, guest supply and cleaning material stock take monthly
- Be aware of guest lost property procedure and ensuring that all items are reported.
- Reporting: maintenance problems, breakages, fire and health hazards, security risks, accidents, lost and found, shortages and unusual events.
- Sign off a completed room check daily.
- Washing and ironing of all lodge linen and towels.
- Turning down the rooms in the evening
- Carry out any other duties as assigned by the supervisor / manager
