PURPOSE OF THE JOB

Position Overview

The incumbent will assist the Technical Manager in coordinating scouting activities, data collection, and analysis to promote continuous improvement and protect orchard health and productivity.

- Maintain accurate orchard history records, including block-level pest trends and treatment outcomes.
- Support the implementation and improvement of scouting protocols and pest management strategies.
