Role Purpose: The Electrical Superintendent, reporting directly to the Engineering Manager, is responsible for the safe, reliable operation and maintenance of all electrical, instrumentation, control, and electronic systems across the Tschudi mining operation, ensuring sustained engineering reliability through the implementation of reliability centred maintenance strategies and techniques. The role entails identifying and managing electrical and electronic asset reliability risks as well as design and installation of new infrastructure for expansion projects in line with all engineering standards.

Key Performance areas:

- Provide focused leadership and supervision to the Electrical and C&I sections, ensuring effective planning, execution, control, and reporting of maintenance and repair activities to achieve plant availability and performance
- Ensure safe, reliable, and efficient Electrical and C&I plant performance by managing and evaluating safety performance across the Plant Electrical, Instrumentation, and System Integration sections in accordance with Ongopolo Mining Ltd procedures, engineering standards, and statutory requirements.
- Establish, approve, and enforce electrical and C&I standards and operating procedures, ensuring full compliance with applicable legislation and health, safety, and environmental directives.
- Assess operational requirements and oversee the selection, specification, installation, and commissioning of electrical and C&I equipment and technologies, ensuring alignment with engineering best practice and long-term plant reliability objectives.
- Review and recommend electrical and C&I design modifications or improvements to enhance safety, reduce unplanned downtime, and improve overall plant efficiency.
- Manage assigned electrical and C&I projects by identifying short- and long-term improvement or modification initiatives and executing them in line with project management principles.
- Drive continuous improvement in maintenance systems, procedures, and execution practices to enhance equipment performance and extend asset life.
- Coordinate with suppliers, contractors, and OEMs to secure timely technical support and cost-effective solutions to electrical and C&I challenges.

- B.Sc / B.Eng / B.Tech in Electrical Engineering; a postgraduate qualification will be an added advantage.
